The total amount of 2017 membership payments we received as of August 7th, 2017 is \$60,662.23 USD from **38** APACPH member institutions. We have **45** more members that have not submitted membership payments this year; I would suggest that the Secretariat send out another friendly reminder. The current balance in Taipei account is \$216,151.46 USD. Please refer to the balance sheet for more details.

Meanwhile, one key issue I would like to bring to our attention is that APACPH treasure office has noticed a decline in membership payments from institutions all over the world since 2015 and this appears to be a concern for our future APACPH development and conference activities. Thus, we would like to kindly ask our KL Secretariat Office to ensure they routinely update the current member's contact information and continue to send out friendly reminders for APACPH membership payment at scheduled times.

As we are only half way through the year, we are expecting more membership fee collection throughout the year. With all the proposed recommendation to improve current available funds, I have faith that our financial situation will further improve. Lastly, the 2017 Budget Projection is enclosed for your review. I look forward to seeing everyone at the Executive Council Meeting on the 15th of August 2017!
