1. 5th AHILA International Health Literacy Conference: Health Literacy and Population Health

The conference programme was finalized. There will be two days conference and one day for pre-conference workshops. Three pre-conference workshops will be conducted on 12th November. The titles of the preconference workshops are 1) Health Literacy: 101, 2) Evaluation of health promotion programme, 3) Statistic evidence on public health research. There will be an APACPH-AHLA networking dinner on 12th Night. The two days conference will include three key note speeches, one plenary, one round table discussions, 5 symposiums and 6 oral presentation sessions. The APACH satellite symposium on global health will be on 14th of November, 2017.
