3. ICUH Future plans

3.1 Development Strategy Workshop

ICUH has been conducting Development Strategy Workshop in every APACPH ECM. During

last ECM on 31 March 2018, all APACPH ECM members discussed ways to develop ICUH Course. A follow-up meeting will be held on 12 September, 2018 including agenda on development of the lecture contents, timeline and ways to enhance collaboration between ICUH and MOU institutes.

3.2 New Cooperation and Promotion

GHSA (Global Health Security Agenda) master degree for international students (Funded by KOICA, Korea International Cooperation Agency) is on-going at Yonsei University from August, 2017. The course aims to provide relevant qualifications to meet national and international needs for a skilled public health professionals. Yonsei and ICUH will cooperate to provide the courses online.

In the meantime, Yonsei University has a meeting with Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences in February 9, 2018. A follow-up meeting was held in Mongolia in June to renew the MOU between School of Public Health in Yonsei University and Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences. This MOU is expected to strengthen not only the collaboration between the two universities but sharing the online course information.
