

APACPH Multi-countries Research Grant Opportunity Proposal Instructions

The Asia-Pacific Academic Consortium for Public Health (APACPH) research fund aims to encourage and support corporative research on public health in the Asia-pacific region. The APACPH research fund is intended to strengthen the international academic exchanges among countries in the Asia-pacific region by providing an opportunity to collaborate with institutions in different countries. The scope of our research fund is broad and multidisciplinary, encouraging all research that contributes to public health in the region.

Language

All correspondence and documents shall be written in English.

Proposal length

The total length of the proposal should be a maximum of 10 pages.

Eligibility of applicants

Eligible applicants are any APACPH member institutions who have paid membership fees for last three years. Individual applicants or/and non-members are not eligible.

All research must cover at least three different countries.

Amount of grant

The maximum amount of grant is 15,000 USD at multi-countries membership institutions in the Asia-Pacific Region.

Outcome measures

Outcome measures can be one of the followings:

- a. White paper
- b. Publications (in international journal such as APJPH)
- c. Capacity building
- d. Human capital development
- e. Programs

Duration of the research

Duration of the research is a maximum of 12 months with a no-cost extension option of one year.

Monitoring of the progress (reporting requirements)

Interim progress report must be submitted within 30 days after the first 6 months and final report is required to be submitted 60 days of the last day of the research.

Please describe methodology and outputs of the research.

f. Expected outcome (max. 200 words)

Please describe the expected outcome of the research and frame a performance indicator. An indicator can be either qualitative or quantitative and shall allow us to directly measure towards achieving the outcome.

g. Collaboration plan and rationale (optional question, max. 150 words)

Please describe capacity and expertise of each collaborator and how the collaboration will increase the probability of success of the research.

h. Timeline and key milestones

Please provide a detailed Gantt chart and indicate key milestones of the research.
